

## Letter dated 9 January 2024 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 2707 (2023), adopted on 14 November 2023, by which the Council decided to extend the mandate of the Panel of Experts on Yemen until 15 December 2024 and requested me to take the necessary administrative measures to that effect.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after consulting the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2140 (2014), I have appointed the following experts:

I have designated Mr. Dash to serve as the Coordinator of the Panel.

Two additional experts will be appointed as soon as possible.

I should be grateful if you could bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
