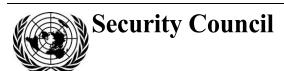

Report of India on the implementation of Security Council resolution 2206 (2015)

The Government of India published an Order dated 5 May 2016 on the implementation of the Security Council resolution on South Sudan in the Gazette of India. The Order was published in order to incorporate into Indian domestic law the sanctions against South Sudan established by the Security Council in its resolution 2206 (2015).

Travel ban

The Order prevents the entry into or transit through its territories of designated individuals. Exemptions are provided in accordance with the above-mentioned resolution.

Asset freeze

The Order provides for the freezing without delay of all funds, other financial assets and economic resources that are on the territories of India and owned or controlled, directly or indirectly, by any individual or entity that may be designated by the Committee, or by any individual or entity acting on their behalf or at their direction, or by entities owned or controlled by them. It also ensures that neither the funds, financial assets or economic resources specified in paragraph 4 (a) of the Order, nor any other funds, financial assets or economic resources, are made available, directly or indirectly, for such persons' benefit by nationals of India or by persons within the territory of India. Exemptions are provided in accordance with the abovementioned resolution.
