**Letter dated 13 February 2014 from the Secretary-General
addressed to the President of the Security Council**

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution [2127 \(2013\)](#) concerning the Central African Republic. By paragraph 59 of the resolution, the Council requested me to create a Panel of Experts for an initial period of thirteen months, in consultation with the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution [2127 \(2013\)](#) concerning the Central African Republic, and to make the necessary financial and security arrangements to support the work of the Panel.

By paragraph 41 of resolution [2134 \(2014\)](#), the Council extended the mandate of the Panel of Experts for a period of one year from the adoption of the resolution (until 27 January 2015).

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after consulting with the Committee, I have appointed the following experts:

Mr. Ruben de Koning, Netherlands (finance/natural resources);

Mr. Paul-Simon Handy, Cameroon (regional);

Mr. Ahmed Himmiche, Morocco (arms);

Mr. Aurélien Llorca, France (armed groups);

Ms. Carolina Reyes Aragon, Colombia (humanitarian).

I have also designated Mr. Llorca to serve as Coordinator of the Panel of Experts.
