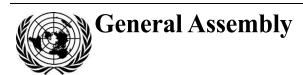

Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 18th and 21st meetings, on 17 and 27 December 2019, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement submitted by the Secretary-General on the programme budget implications of draft resolution A/74/L.20 (A/C.5/74/13) and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/74/7/Add.30). The statements and comments made in the course of the Fifth Committee's consideration of this question are reflected in the relevant summary records. ¹
- 2. At its 21st meeting, on 27 December, the Committee had before it a draft decision (A/C.5/74/L.17, sect. C), submitted by the Chair of the Committee on the basis of informal consultations coordinated by the representative of Kuwait. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft decision A/C.5/74/L.17 without a vote (see para. 3).

Decision of the Fifth Committee

3. The Fifth Committee, having considered the statement of programme budget implications submitted by the Secretary-General ¹ and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, ² decides to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/74/L.20, additional resources amounting to 145,700 United States dollars would be required for 2020 under section 1, Overall policymaking, direction and coordination, of the proposed programme budget for 2020, representing a charge against the contingency fund.
