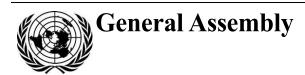

# Report of the Fifth Committee

### I. Introduction

- 1. The previous recommendations made by the Fifth Committee to the General Assembly under agenda item 136 are set out in the report of the Committee contained in document A/76/634.
- 2. During the first part of the resumed seventy-sixth session, the Fifth Committee met formally and remotely owing to the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic, during which it resumed its consideration of the item. The Committee formally resumed its consideration of the item in person at its 11th and 12th meetings, on 9 and 31 March 2022. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee's formal consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary records. <sup>1</sup>
