

Letter dated 13 November 2007 from the Secretary-General to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to my letter of 28 September 2007 (S/2007/575), informing you of the appointment, for a period of six months, of four experts to serve on the Monitoring Group on Somalia re-established pursuant to Security Council resolution 1766 (2007).

I was subsequently informed that Edwina Thompson, one of the experts, was unable to assume her functions. I should like to inform you that, following consultations with the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 751 (1992) concerning Somalia, I have appointed Charles M. Lengalenga (Zambia) to replace Ms. Thompson as finance expert for the Group.

I should be grateful if you would bring this information to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
