

Report of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006) prepared in accordance with the presidential statement of 13 April 2009 (S/PRST/2009/7)

In a presidential statement of 13 April 2009, the Security Council agreed to adjust the measures imposed by paragraph 8 of its resolution 1718 (2006) through the designation of entities and goods, and directed the Committee established pursuant to the same resolution to undertake its tasks to that effect and to report to the Council by 24 April 2009.

Pursuant to the aforementioned presidential statement, the Committee adopted, on 24 April 2009, the decision attached to the present report (see enclosure).

The Committee will continue to undertake its tasks as mandated in paragraph 12 of resolution 1718 (2006).

Decision of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006)

For the purpose of implementing resolution 1718 (2006):

Goods

The Committee determines that the items listed in document S/2009/205 shall be subject to the measures imposed in paragraphs 8 (a), (b) and (c) of resolution 1718 (2006).

Entities

The Committee designates the following entities to be subject to the provisions of and the measures imposed in paragraph 8 (d) of resolution 1718 (2006):

- Korea Mining Development Trading Corporation (also known as Changgwang Sinyong Corporation; also known as External Technology General Corporation; also known as DPRKN Mining Development Trading Cooperation; also known as "KOMID"). Central District, Pyongyang, Democratic People's Republic of Korea. Primary arms dealer and main exporter of goods and equipment related to ballistic missiles and conventional weapons.
- 2. **Korea Ryonbong General Corporation** (also known as Korea Yonbong General Corporation; formerly known as Lyongaksan General Trading Corporation). Pot'onggang District, Pyongyang, Democratic People's Republic of Korea; Rakwon-dong, Pothonggang District, Pyongyang, Democratic People's Republic of Korea. Defence conglomerate specializing in acquisition for defence industries of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and support to that country's military-related sales.
- 3. Tanchon Commercial Bank (formerly known as Changgwang Credit Bank; formerly known as, Korea Changgwang Credit Bank). Saemul 1-Dong Pyongchon District, Pyongyang, Democratic People's Republic of Korea. Main financial entity of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea for sales of conventional arms, ballistic missiles and goods related to the assembly and manufacture of such weapons.
