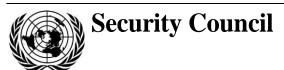

Letter dated 12 March 2015 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 2200 (2015), adopted on 12 February 2015, by which the Council decided to extend until 12 March 2016 the mandate of the Panel of Experts originally appointed pursuant to resolution 1591 (2005), and requested that I should take the necessary administrative measures.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after consulting with the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1591 (2005) concerning the Sudan, I have appointed the following experts:

- Ms. Dakshinie Ruwanthika Gunaratne, international humanitarian law (Sri Lanka)
- Mr. Issa Maraut, regional issues (France)
- Mr. Guido Potters, aviation (the Netherlands)
- Mr. Abhai Srivastav, finance (India)
- Mr. Adrian Wilkinson, weapons (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland).

I have designated Mr. Srivastav to serve as Coordinator of the Panel of Experts.

I should be grateful if you would bring this letter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
