Letter dated 20 November 2015 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 2244 (2015), adopted on 23 October 2015, concerning Somalia and Eritrea. By paragraph 31 of the resolution, the Council decided to extend the mandate of the Monitoring Group on Somalia and Eritrea until 15 December 2016.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after having consulted with the Security Council Committee pursuant to resolutions 751 (1992) and 1907 (2009) concerning Somalia and Eritrea, I have appointed the following experts:

Jay Bahadur, armed groups (Canada) Charles Cater, natural resources (United States of America) Bogdan Chetreanu, finance (Romania) Déirdre Clancy, humanitarian affairs (Ireland) Tapani Holopainen, finance (Finland) Rufus Kalidheen, arms (South Africa) James Smith, regional (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland) Christophe Trajber, maritime/transport (France).

I have designated Mr. Trajber to serve as Coordinator of the Monitoring Group on Somalia and Eritrea.
