Letter dated 14 December 2016 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 2317 (2016), adopted on 10 November 2016, concerning Somalia and Eritrea. By paragraph 38 of the resolution, the Council decided to extend until 15 December 2017 the mandate of the Monitoring Group on Somalia and Eritrea.
