

Letter dated 20 August 2018 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 2428 (2018), by which the Council decided to extend until 1 July 2019 the mandate of the Panel of Experts on South Sudan, as set out in paragraph 18 of Council resolution 2206 (2015) and paragraph 19 of resolution 2428 (2018).

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after consulting with the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2206 (2015) concerning South Sudan, I have appointed the following experts to serve on the Panel until 1 July 2019:

Mr. Michael Gibb, natural resources (Norway)

Mr. Dean Gillespie, arms (South Africa)

Mr. Andrei Kolmakov, finance (Russian Federation)

Ms. Renifa Madenga, humanitarian affairs (Zimbabwe)

Mr. Emilio Manfredi, armed groups/regional issues (Italy)

I have designated Mr. Gibb to serve as Coordinator of the Panel.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
