Report of the Republic of Palau, pursuant to paragraph 6 of Security Council resolution 1455 (2003), to the Committee established pursuant to resolution 1267 (1999)

## Introduction

Security Council resolutions 1267 (1999), 1333 (2000), 1373 (2001), 1390 (2002) and 1455 (2003) provide an important framework for the international response to terrorism. The Republic of Palau is fully committed to cooperating with the United Nations, its Member States and the Committee established pursuant to resolution 1267 (1999) in implementing sanctions against the Taliban and Al-Qaida organization, and any individuals, groups, or entities associated therewith that have participated in the financing, planning, facilitating and preparation of perpetration of terrorist acts or in supporting terrorist acts.

## Steps taken to implement measures imposed by resolutions

The Republic of Palau has implemented measures whereby all financial institutions are provided with a list of names and identifying information which is provided to the Republic of Palau pursuant to resolution 1390 (2002). The financial institutions are required to report if they have any accounts or transactions dealing with those names. To date, there have been no reports of any such transactions or accounts, and therefore there have been no investigations or enforcement actions and no freezing of assets of listed individuals or entities.
