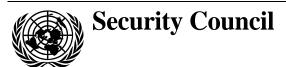

The Permanent Mission of the People's Republic of China to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1533 (2004) and, pursuant to resolution 1896 (2009), has the honour to transmit herewith a report on the steps taken by the Government of the People's Republic of China to implement resolution 1896 (2009).

Report of China on the implementation of Security Council resolution 1896 (2009)

Since the adoption of resolution 1896 (2009), the Government of China has taken steps to implement the measures contained in the resolution. The Foreign Ministry, authorized by the State Council, has informed the ministries and commissions under the State Council, the governments of the provinces, autonomous regions and the Special Administrative Regions of Hong Kong and Macao of the resolution 1896 (2009) and requested that it be implemented accordingly.

Regarding paragraph 1 of the resolution, since the Security Council imposed an arms embargo against the Democratic Republic of the Congo, the Chinese Government has earnestly implemented the embargo and the relevant exemption measures.

Regarding paragraph 3, the Chinese Government has continuously implemented the assets freeze and travel ban measures in accordance with the list of individuals and entities designated by the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1533 (2004), and the measures against the individuals and entities stipulated in paragraphs 9 and 11 of resolution 1807 (2008).

Regarding paragraph 12, the Chinese Government has decided to appoint Mr. Baogang Zhao, the expert in charge of issues concerning the Democratic Republic of the Congo in the Permanent Mission of China to the United Nations, as the focal point between the Chinese side and the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1533 (2004).

Regarding paragraph 14, the relevant ministries of the Chinese Government have, on the basis of the notice on sanctions against the Democratic Republic of the Congo issued by the Chinese Foreign Ministry, taken measures to urge the importers, processing industries and consumers of mineral products from the Democratic Republic of the Congo under their jurisdiction to exercise due diligence over their suppliers and the origin of the minerals they purchase.
