Report of San Marino on the implementation of Security Council resolution 2360 (2017)

As with past resolutions concerning the Democratic Republic of the Congo, the Republic of San Marino has taken steps to implement the provisions contained in resolution 2360 (2017).

Measures adopted through Security Council resolutions become enforceable in San Marino through decisions of the Congress of State (Government), which provide a list of the measures to be enforced and mandate the competent San Marino authorities to implement them.

On 31 July 2017, the San Marino Congress of State adopted Decision No. 3, entitled "Provisions implementing the measures adopted by the United Nations Security Council with respect to the Democratic Republic of the Congo",* along with the annex thereto, entitled "The list established and maintained pursuant to Security Council resolution 1533 (2004)".

All future changes made to the list of entities and individuals established and maintained by the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1533 (2004) will be posted on a dedicated section of the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of San Marino within one working day of receipt of the relevant notice from the Committee.
