Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1591 (2005) concerning the Sudan

Note verbale dated 18 July 2012 from the Permanent Mission of Argentina to the United Nations addressed to the Chairman of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of the Argentine Republic to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1591 (2005) concerning the Sudan and, in relation to the latter's note verbale dated 4 June 2012, has the honour to report that the measures adopted by the Security Council in its resolutions 1556 (2004) and 1591 (2005) concerning the Sudan were promulgated through decision No. 1770/2006 of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Worship, dated 23 August 2006, and that the measures adopted by the Security Council in its resolution 1672 (2006), also concerning the Sudan, were promulgated through decision No. 81/2007 of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Worship, dated 23 January 2007.

The Permanent Mission of the Argentine Republic to the United Nations also has the honour to report that, on 6 July 2012, the Directorate of International Organizations of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Worship of the Argentine Republic communicated the updated list of persons and entities subject to the sanctions regime established by the Committee to the following agencies of the national Government: the Office for the Coordination of Work on International Topics of the Ministry of Justice and Human Rights; the Planning Secretariat of the Ministry of Security; the Intelligence Secretariat; the Financial Information Unit; the Federal Administration of Public Revenue; the General Directorate of Customs; the Central Bank of the Argentine Republic; the National Bank of Argentina; and the National Directorate of Migration.
