

Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1591 (2005) concerning the Sudan

Note verbale dated 19 December 2013 from the Permanent Mission of the Philippines to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of the Philippines presents its compliments to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1591 (2005) concerning the Sudan.

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of the Philippines has the honour to convey the action taken by the Government of the Republic of the Philippines with reference to the amendments on Security Council resolution 2091 (2013), imposing a military embargo on the Government of the Sudan:

- The Philippine National Police, through the different concerned units, disseminated and is continuously monitoring the implementation of Security Council resolution 2091 (2013) as well as the amendments stipulated in SCA/1/13(13), in particular paragraphs 2 and 9, which urge all Member States to be aware of the risk in supplying aircraft and related technical assistance and support to the Government of the Sudan;
- To date, there has been no monitored breach or violation on the imposition of a military embargo on the Government of the Sudan in terms of technical assistance and/or military training. Furthermore, no issuance of licences/permits to export firearms, ammunition and/or explosives to the Sudan was monitored.
