**Report of the Royal Thai Government pursuant to paragraph 22
of Security Council resolution 1874 (2009)**

1. On 14 July 2009, the Cabinet instructed the relevant agencies to implement Security Council resolution 1874 (2009) in accordance with laws and regulations of Thailand, in particular:

The Act Controlling the Exportation of Arms, Armament and War Implements (1952)

The Munitions of War Control Act (1987)

The Royal Decree Controlling the Exportation of Arms, Armament and War Implements (1992)

The Atomic Energy for Peace Act (1961)

The Export and Import Goods Act (1979)

The Disease Control Act (1980)

The Hazardous Substance Act (1992)

The Carriage of Goods by Sea Act B.E. 2534 (1991)

The Law on Navigation in Thai Waters B.E. 2456 (1913)

The Financial Institutions Business Act B.E. 2551 (2008)

The Anti-Money-Laundering Acts B.E. 2542 (1999) and B.E. 2551 (2008).

2. Measures that have been taken pursuant to Security Council resolution 1718 (2006) still remain in force.

3. Regarding the import-export control list, the Ministry of Commerce issued an announcement on the prohibition of the export to and import from the Democratic People's Republic of Korea of arms and armament as well as those arms and armament that originated from the Democratic People's Republic of Korea.

4. The Bank of Thailand shall fully cooperate, to the extent permitted by the laws of Thailand, with competent Thai agencies in implementing Security Council resolution 1874 (2009) in relation to commercial banks and financial institutions under the purview of the Bank of Thailand.

5. On 25 August 2009, the Cabinet acknowledged the list of entities, goods and individuals designated, pursuant to paragraph 24 of Security Council resolution 1874 (2009), on 16 July 2009 by the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006). The Ministry of Foreign Affairs has already informed the concerned authorities of the list.
