**Security Council Committee established
pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006)****Note verbale dated 24 July 2009 from the Permanent
Representative of the Principality of Liechtenstein to the
United Nations addressed to the Chairman of the Committee**

The Permanent Representative of the Principality of Liechtenstein to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006) concerning the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and has the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 1874 (2009), adopted by the Council on 12 June 2009, and wishes to communicate the following:

Liechtenstein has fully implemented the provisions of paragraph 8 of resolution 1718 (2006), as reflected in the previous report submitted by Liechtenstein (S/AC.49/2006/5). The extended scope of application of these measures, as provided for by paragraphs 9 and 10 of resolution 1874 (2009), has been incorporated into national law through a revision to the Government Ordinance on Measures concerning the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (Liechtenstein Legal Gazette 2009, No. 195). The above-mentioned Ordinance is regularly updated following relevant decisions by the sanctions Committee, for example, with respect to designated individuals and entities.

As of 1 March 2009, Government Ordinances on international sanctions regimes are based on the Sanctions Act (LLG 2009, No. 41). This new law improves the legal basis for international cooperation in the implementation of sanctions and for data protection, sets clear responsibilities for enforcement and increases the penalties for sanctions violations.
