Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006)

Note verbale dated 20 May 2013 from the Permanent Mission of Belgium to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of Belgium to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006) and, in accordance with paragraph 25 of resolution 2094 (2013), has the honour to transmit to the Committee the following information regarding the implementation of the provisions of the resolution.

Belgium is a co-sponsor of Security Council resolution 2094 (2013) and favours its quick implementation.

Belgium and the other member States of the European Union are jointly implementing the restrictive measures set forth in resolution 2094 (2013). They have adopted Council decision 2013/183/CFSP of 22 April 2013 concerning restrictive measures against the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and repealing decision 2010/800/CFSP.*

Additional European Union sanctions are being considered and regulation with regard to activities that could contribute to the nuclear or ballistic missile programmes of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea will be updated.
