
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Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006)

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of San Marino to the United Nations has the honour to submit the report of the Republic of San Marino on the implementation of Security Council resolutions 1718 (2006), 1874 (2009), 2087 (2013), 2094 (2013) and 2270 (2016) concerning the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (see annex).

Measures taken by San Marino to implement certain provisions set out in Security Council resolutions 1718 (2006), 1874 (2009), 2087 (2013), 2094 (2013) and 2270 (2016)

As with past resolutions concerning the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, San Marino has taken steps to implement the provisions contained in Security Council resolution 2270 (2016).

Measures adopted through Security Council resolutions become enforceable in San Marino through decisions of the Congress of State (Government), which provide a list of the measures to be enforced and mandate the competent authorities of San Marino to implement them.

On 4 May 2016, the San Marino Congress of State adopted Decision No. 5, entitled "Provisions implementing the measures adopted by the United Nations Security Council with respect to the Democratic People's Republic of Korea".*

All future changes made to the list of entities and individuals established and maintained by the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006) will be posted on a dedicated section of the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of San Marino within one working day of receipt of the relevant notice from the Committee.
