

- The Special Investigation Commission (Anti-Money-Laundering) of the Banque du Liban has been instructed to take the necessary measures to ban the travel of the individuals and freeze the assets of the entities.
- The General Directorate of Customs has been instructed to prohibit the entry of luxury goods.
- The General Directorate of General Security has been instructed to prohibit the entry into Lebanese territory of persons on the travel ban list.
- The Ministry of Public Works and Transport has been instructed to notify seaports to deny entry to vessels belonging to the Ocean Maritime Management Company, Limited (OMM) as well as aquatic recreational vehicles (such as personal watercraft).
