

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of San Marino to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006) and has the honour to submit the report of San Marino on the implementation of Security Council resolution 2321 (2016), concerning non-proliferation in the Democratic People's Republic of Korea.

## Report of San Marino on the implementation of Security Council resolution 2321 (2016)

As with past resolutions concerning the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, the Republic of San Marino has taken steps to implement the provisions contained in resolution 2321 (2016).

Measures adopted through Security Council resolutions become enforceable in San Marino through decisions of the Congress of State (Government), which provide a list of the measures to be enforced and mandate the competent authorities of San Marino to implement them.

On 26 February 2017, the San Marino Congress of State adopted decision No. 2, on provisions implementing the measures adopted by the Security Council with respect to the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (herewith enclosed, along with the following annexes thereto):\*

- (a) Measures adopted by the Security Council with respect to the Democratic People's Republic of Korea;
  - (b) List established and maintained by the Committee;
  - (c) New conventional arms dual-use list.

The decision and annex 1 are provided both in the original Italian version and in the courtesy translation into English.

All future changes made to list of entities and individuals established and maintained by the Committee will be posted on a dedicated section of the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of San Marino within one working day of the receipt of the relevant notice from the Committee.
