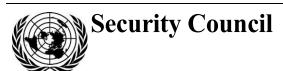



## Report of Bahrain on the implementation of Security Council resolution 2321 (2016)

With regard to paragraph 36 of Security Council resolution 2321 (2016), the Kingdom of Bahrain reiterates that it was notified of the resolution and that it has informed all relevant Government ministries and agencies of the resolution's provisions, so that they might take the required measures. They have, in fact, taken several measures, including, inter alia:

- All the Kingdom's ports (land, sea and air) were instructed to scrutinize all shipments passing through Bahraini territory that come from or are destined for the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, or to otherwise scrutinize any suspicious shipments.
- All the Kingdom's ports (land, sea and air) were instructed to prevent the persons whose names appear in the list annexed to the resolution from travelling.
- All banks and licensed financial institutions were instructed to take the measures required to implement the provisions of the resolution.
