## Report of Bahrain on the implementation of Security Council resolutions 2270 (2016), 2356 (2017), 2371 (2017) and 2375 (2017)

The Kingdom of Bahrain is committed to the Security Council resolutions adopted under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations concerning sanctions on the Democratic People's Republic of Korea. The National Committee on Follow-up to Security Council Resolutions has transmitted the provisions of the resolutions to all ministries and relevant Government actors in order for them to take appropriate measures in accordance with established procedure.

Some of the measures taken by the competent authorities are set out below:

- All airlines and land, sea and air crossings in Bahrain have been instructed to implement all of the relevant provisions of the resolutions, including the travel ban and the requirement to seek out, detect and confiscate prohibited items.
- The Chamber of Industry and Commerce of Bahrain, the National Oil and Gas Authority and all departments of the Ministry of Industry, Trade and Tourism have been instructed to implement the provisions of the resolutions.
- All banks and licensed financial institutions in Bahrain have been instructed to take the necessary action to implement the provisions of the resolutions.
- The National Committee is periodically monitoring the situation in order to ensure that the provisions of the resolutions are implemented comprehensively and continuously.
