

Report of Spain on the implementation of Security Council resolution 2397 (2017)

Spain hereby transmits the report on the specific measures that it has adopted to implement paragraph 8 of Security Council resolution 2397 (2017):

- 1. The States members of the European Union have jointly implemented the restrictive measures against the Democratic People's Republic of Korea set forth in Security Council 2397 (2017) by adopting the following common measures:
 - Council Decision (CFSP) 2018/293 of 26 February 2018 amending Decision (CFSP) 2016/849 concerning restrictive measures against the Democratic People's Republic of Korea;
 - Council Regulation (EU) 2018/285 of 26 February 2018 amending Council Regulation (EU) 2017/1509 concerning restrictive measures against the Democratic People's Republic of Korea.
- 2. Pursuant to paragraph 8 of Security Council resolution 2397 (2017), Spain reports that there is currently one employed North Korean resident in the country whose residence permit expires on 21 June. The Spanish authorities are taking steps to ensure that it is not renewed, in accordance with national laws.
