**Report of Romania on the implementation of Security Council
resolution [2397 \(2017\)](#)**

As a State member of the European Union, Romania has jointly incorporated the provisions of paragraph 8 of Security Council resolution [2397 \(2017\)](#) into the European Union legal order by adopting Council Decision (CFSP) 2018/293 of 26 February 2018 amending Decision (CFSP) 2016/849 concerning restrictive measures against the Democratic People's Republic of Korea.¹

The Council Decision sets out the commitment of the European Union to implement the measures contained in the resolution. Article 1, paragraph 8, of the Council Decision, incorporating paragraph 8 of the resolution, imposes the obligation to repatriate to the Democratic People's Republic of Korea all nationals of that country earning income in that Member State's jurisdiction and all government safety oversight attachés from the Democratic People's Republic of Korea monitoring workers abroad from that country immediately, but no later than 21 December 2019, unless certain exceptions apply, subject to applicable national and international law.

The above-mentioned Decision is binding in its entirety on States members of the European Union.

Since the adoption of Security Council resolution [2397 \(2017\)](#), Romania has carefully observed the full implementation of all its provisions. Romania does not host nationals of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea to whom the repatriation requirement pursuant to paragraph 8 of the resolution applies. Measures to ensure that no new workers from the Democratic People's Republic of Korea are employed have also been taken at the national level.
