Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006)

Note verbale dated 24 March 2020 from the Permanent Mission of Liechtenstein to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of the Principality of Liechtenstein to the United Nations has the honour to refer to paragraph 8 of Security Council resolution 2397 (2017) of 22 December 2017, in which the Council decided that all Member States should submit a final report on all nationals of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea earning income in a Member State's jurisdiction who were repatriated in compliance with resolution 2397 (2017).

In that regard, the Government of the Principality of Liechtenstein has the honour to inform the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006) that the following information submitted in its midterm report (S/AC.49/2019/31) remains valid:

(a) No nationals of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea have resided or been employed in the Principality of Liechtenstein since the adoption of resolution 2397 (2017);

(b) Accordingly, no nationals of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea have been repatriated pursuant to paragraph 8 of resolution 2397 (2017);

(c) The Government of the Principality of Liechtenstein continues to exert all efforts to fully implement sanctions resolutions of the Security Council.
