Final report on the implementation of paragraph 8 of Security Council resolution 2397 (2017) concerning the Democratic People's Republic of Korea

With regard to the effective implementation of paragraph 8 of Security Council resolution 2397 (2017), concerning the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, and other related Council resolutions by which the Council prohibits that country from developing nuclear weapons and ballistic missiles and which provide for sanctions on persons or entities involved in such programmes, the Government of Mexico, through the Specialized High-level Committee on Disarmament, Terrorism and International Security, reports the following:

- The Committee is applying measures at the national level, in compliance with resolution 2397 (2017), through the competent authorities.
- The National Institute for Migration has instructed its representative offices, as of 31 December 2019, to deny all applications by nationals of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea for visas tied to offers of employment, except where it is deemed that a humanitarian or denuclearization issue is involved.
- The Ministry of Security and Civil Protection and the Financial Intelligence Unit of the Ministry of Finance and Public Credit report that thorough inspections have revealed no record of nationals of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea earning income in Mexican territory.
