

Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1970 (2011) concerning Libya

Note verbale dated 25 July 2011 from the Permanent Mission of Monaco to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of the Principality of Monaco to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1970 (2011) concerning Libya and, in response to his notes verbales of 25 March 2011, 21 June 2011 and 2 April 2012, has the honour to provide the following information, pursuant to paragraph 25 of resolution 1970 (2011), in which the Council called upon all Member States to report to the Committee within 120 days of the adoption of the resolution on the steps they had taken with a view to implementing effectively paragraphs 9, 10, 15 and 17 of that resolution and the relevant provisions of resolution 1973 (2011), which set out the terms of the arms embargo, the travel ban and the asset freeze.

- The Principality adopted, on 8 March 2011, Ministerial Order No. 2011-118 imposing measures for the freezing of funds and economic resources of individuals, entities and bodies designated by the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1970 (2011). This Ministerial Order has been amended four times and includes, in annex I, the list of natural or legal persons, entities and bodies designated by the Sanctions Committee pursuant to paragraph 22 of resolution 1970 (2011) or in paragraphs 19, 22 and 23 of resolution 1973 (2011) (see Journal de Monaco of 11 March 2011 and of 17 June 2011).
- Concerning the arms embargo and restrictions on the movement of individuals and pursuant to the Customs Convention between France and Monaco and its participation in the Schengen area, the Principality enforces the same rules as does the European Union.
