Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2048 (2012) concerning Guinea-Bissau

Note verbale dated 3 October 2012 from the Permanent Mission of France to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of France to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairperson of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2048 (2012) concerning Guinea-Bissau and wishes to inform him of the measures taken by France within the framework of the implementation of paragraph 4 of resolution 2048 (2012).

The European Union approved the restrictive measures targeted against the persons who threaten peace, security and stability in Guinea-Bissau. These measures are currently in force under European Union Council regulation No. 377/2012 of 3 May 2012.

At the national level, the names of the persons listed in the annex to resolution 2048 (2012) have been registered in the visa base for the purpose of refusal to issue a visa, through notification, if a request is submitted.
