**Report of the Government of the Republic of Lithuania regarding  
the implementation of Security Council resolution 2140 (2014)**

The framework for the implementation of international sanctions in the Republic of Lithuania is established by the Law on the Implementation of Economic and other International Sanctions (2004).<sup>a</sup> The Ministry of Foreign Affairs coordinates the implementation of international sanctions in the Republic of Lithuania and provides natural and legal persons with information about the issues pertaining to the implementation of those sanctions.<sup>b</sup>

The international sanctions are imposed by the directly applicable regulations of the European Union and the resolutions of the Government of the Republic of Lithuania, which implement other legislation of the European Union, as well as resolutions of the Security Council and decisions of the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe.

Security Council resolution 2140 (2014), which imposes sanctions on Yemen, is implemented through the following legislation.

1. At the European Union level:

(a) Council Decision 2014/932/CFSP of 18 December 2014 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Yemen (*Official Journal of the European Union*, OL L 365, 19 December 2014, p. 147);

(b) Council Regulation (EU) No. 1352/2014 of 18 December 2014 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Yemen (*Official Journal of the European Union*, OL L 365, 19 December 2014, p. 60). This regulation is directly applicable in Lithuania in terms of the asset freeze.

2. At the national level, individuals subject to the travel ban were included in the national travel ban list following the procedure set out in the Government resolution on the implementation of political sanctions that prohibit the entry or transit of individuals through the territory of the Republic of Lithuania (2008).<sup>c</sup>
