Report to the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2206 (2015) concerning South Sudan

1. Regarding paragraph 9 of resolution 2206 (2015), the Government of Japan will take measures based on the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act (1951) to prevent the entry into Japan and transit through Japanese territory of individuals to be designated by the Sanctions Committee.
 2. Regarding paragraph 12 of resolution 2206 (2015), the Government of Japan will take measures based on the Foreign Exchange and Foreign Trade Act (1948) to prevent the transfer of financial resources to and from individuals and entities to be designated by the Sanctions Committee.
