Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2206 (2015) concerning South Sudan

Note verbale dated 3 June 2015 from the Permanent Mission of Monaco to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of the Principality of Monaco to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2206 (2015) concerning South Sudan and, with reference to the Committee's note verbale dated 1 April 2015, has the honour to provide the following information.

- With regard to freezing assets, the Principality adopted, on 24 July 2014, Ministerial Order No. 2014-426 (attached hereto)* concerning South Sudan, imposing measures for the freezing of funds and economic resources of individuals designated by the European Union in the context of the European common security policy. Through an amendment to the annex to this Ministerial Order, the Principality will implement all decisions to include an individual or entity on the list of individuals subject to a measure for the freezing of funds taken by the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2206 (2015).
- With regard to restrictions on the movement of persons, and because of its inclusion in the Schengen area, the Principality enforces the same rules as does the European Union. Therefore, those measures apply in the Principality from the moment of their adoption by the European Union.
