

Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2206 (2015) concerning South Sudan

Note verbale dated 2 June 2017 from the Permanent Mission of Senegal to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Senegal to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2206 (2015) concerning South Sudan and, with reference to the Committee's note verbale dated 1 April 2015, has the honour to provide the following information:

- With regard to the asset freeze, the Ministry of Economic Affairs, Finance and Planning has sent banks and quasi-banking financial institutions the list of the six designated persons subject to sanctions.
- With regard to restrictions on the movement of persons, the National Gendarmerie and the airport services have been informed about the measures which need to be taken. All units of the territorial gendarmerie, especially those on the borders, have thus been instructed to search for and arrest the persons subject to the sanctions regime if they enter or pass through Senegal.
