Letter dated 28 March 2013 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 2094 (2013), by which the Council decided to extend, until 7 April 2014, the mandate of the Panel of Experts, as specified in paragraph 26 of its resolution 1874 (2009), and requested the Secretary-General to take the necessary administrative measures to that effect.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after consulting with the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006), I have reappointed the following experts:

- Mr. Katsuhisa Furukawa, Japan (nuclear issues);
- Mr. Chang Guo, China (export control and nuclear items);
- Mr. Jang-keun Lee, Republic of Korea (proliferation of weapons of mass destruction);
- Mr. Erik Marzolf, France (missile technology);
- Mr. William J. Newcomb, United States of America (finance);
- Mr. Martin Uden, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (regional issues);
- Mr. Alexander Vilnin, Russian Federation (customs).

An eighth expert will be appointed shortly.

I have also designated Mr. Martin Uden to serve as Coordinator of the Panel of Experts.

I should be grateful if you would bring this information to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
