Report on the implementation of Security Council resolution 1970 (2011)

The Ministry of Interior of the Republic of Iraq instructed all authorities concerned to prevent the entry of the persons listed in the “travel ban”, attached to Security Council resolution 1970 (2011), to enter Iraqi territories or transit through Iraq into other countries.

The Central Bank of Iraq instructed all banks and money-transferring companies to freeze any accounts or deposits, which are subject to the freezing of assets, belonging to the persons listed in the “assets freeze”, attached to Security Council resolution 1970 (2011).
