Measures taken by San Marino to implement the provisions set out in resolution [2339 \(2017\)](#)

The following is a brief description of the steps taken by the Republic of San Marino to implement the provisions contained in resolution [2339 \(2017\)](#).

Measures adopted through Security Council resolutions become enforceable in San Marino through decisions of the Congress of State (Government), which provide a list of the measures to be enforced and mandates the competent authorities of San Marino to implement them.

On 31 July 2017, the San Marino Congress of State adopted Decision No. 4, entitled “Provisions implementing the measures adopted by the United Nations Security Council with respect to the Central African Republic”, and the annex thereto, entitled “The list established and maintained by the [2127 \(2013\)](#) Committee”.¹

All future changes made to the list of entities and individuals established and maintained by the [2127 \(2013\)](#) Committee will be posted on a dedicated section of the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of San Marino within one working day from the receipt of the relevant notice from the Committee.
